



## **Hallelujah Kingdom Ministry**

### **Non-Denominational Ministry**

**Below are our core beliefs:**

#### **The Godhead (The Trinity)**

**We believe in one God existing as the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit.**

**We believe in one God the Father as creator (1 Corinthians 8:6), Jesus Christ as fully God and human who came to save humanity (John 1:14), and the Holy Spirit who indwells and guides believers (John 14:16-17).**

#### **The Godhead:**

- **One God in three persons (The Trinity): We believe in one God who exists as three distinct but co-equal persons: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ), and God the Holy Spirit.**

- **God the Father: The creator and sustainer of the universe.**
- **God the Son (Jesus Christ):**
- **We believe Jesus was God incarnate—both fully divine and fully human—who was born of the Virgin Mary. He came to earth to save humanity from sin.**
- **God the Holy Spirit: The Spirit of God who lives within believers to guide, comfort, and empowers them.**

### **Jesus Christ:**

- **Crucifixion and resurrection: A cornerstone of Christian belief is that Jesus was crucified as a sacrifice for the sins of humanity. We believe he was resurrected from the dead three days later, proving his power over sin and death and offering hope for eternal life to those who believe in him.**
- **The path to Salvation:**
- **We believe that salvation—or being saved from God's righteous judgment—is a gift of grace received through faith in Jesus Christ, not by human works.**
- **Second Coming:**

- **We believe that Jesus will return to earth at some point in the future to judge the living and the dead and establish his eternal kingdom.**

### **Jesus Christ's Mission:**

**Jesus' crucifixion was a sacrifice for sins, and his resurrection signifies victory over death. 1**

**Corinthians 15:3-4 says that Christ died for sins, was buried, and was raised on the third day. Salvation is a gift received through faith in Jesus, as explained in Ephesians 2:8-9, not through works. Jesus will soon return to judge and establish his kingdom, as described in Matthew 24:30.**

### **The Bible Scripture:**

- **The Bible, God's Holy Word, consisting of (66) Books. (39) of the Old Testaments and (27) New Testaments. The Old Testament records the history of God's covenant with the Israelites, while the New Testament chronicles the life of Jesus and the beginning of the church.**

**The Bible is considered God's inspired and authoritative word, providing guidance. 2 Timothy 3:16 states that all Scripture is breathed out by God and is profitable for teaching, correction, and training.**

### **Sin and Humanity:**

**Humanity was created by God but sinned, causing separation from him. Romans 5:12 says that sin and death entered the world through one man.**

**Marriage:**

**God created marriage as a holy and divine institution for the lifelong union of one man (Male) and one woman (Female). Genesis 2:24, affirmed by Jesus in Matthew 19:4–6, describes a man leaving his parents to hold fast to his wife, becoming one flesh.**

**We believe marriage is an reflection of Christ's love for the Church, the bride of Christ, as in Ephesians 5:25.**

**The Church:**

**The Church is understood as God's family on Earth, composed of believers. 1 Corinthians 12:12 describes this as one body with many members.**
